
Suspected Sexual Assault



For all patients consider:

- Emergency contraception
- Post exposure prophylaxis for BBV and GUM assessment for STIs
- Counselling

Emergency Contraception:

Oral emergency contraception is effective up to 72 hours post intercourse

- In hours nearest pharmacy is Boots at Cameron Toll (If sending patient there call pharmacist to alert them that patient will be attending branch phone 0131 6661111. Opening hours 8:30-19:00 Mon Sat, 9:30 17:30 Sun. Emergency contraception is free of charge)
- Out of Hours contact GP out of hours service
- Alternatively emergency contraception is available from Gynae triage

If oral emergency contraception is not indicated due to time delay or patient contraindications then refer for urgent gynae assessment as IUD may be appropriate.
