<b>Medication</b>	prescribed and chart signed ( <b>ME or PGD</b> )
<b>IV medication/fluids</b>	prescribed & chart signed
<b>Enoxaparin</b>	prescribed and TED's fitted
<b>BadgerNet</b>	Medication Note (Or recorded on Labour Assessment) completed for all medication given
<b>Rh Negative</b>	bloods to lab from mother and cord blood from baby
<b>SAFER Risk Assessment</b> for DVT prophylaxis saved and moved to delivered folder

<b>Onset of Labour &amp; Birth</b>	First Stage, Second Stage, Delivery, Post Delivery, Episiotomy/Tears & Perineal Trauma, Blood Loss, Postnatal Observations (CS Operation)
<b>Risk Assessments</b>	Intrapartum Risk Assessment, PPH Prevention Assessment, Intrapartum/Postnatal, Management Plan, Postnatal VTE, Lifestyle Update, Care Plan Updated at Delivery
<b>Baby</b>	Demographic Details, GP Details, Delivery Details, APGARS and Resus, First Examination, First Feed, Management Plan, Vitamin K, CS, Forceps, Ventouse or Breech Delivery (If relevant), Baby Risk Assessment
<b>BadgerNet PDF Reports</b>	Check all Data on PDF Reports is complete and recorded
<b>Mother Labour and Delivery summary</b>	Confirm and Save then Authorise
<b>Operation Assisted Delivery</b>	Confirm and Save then Authorise
<b>Baby Labour and Delivery</b>	Confirm and Save then Authorise
<b>Transfer to Community Midwifery care</b>	Save Reports
<b>BadgerNet Checks</b>	(Green Ticks) Labour and Birth Tab: SMR02 Delivery
<b>EPIDURAL</b>	Recorded on BadgerNet.

<b>SBR: Minimal Information:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Woman's address and Name of GP</li> <li>• Place of birth: Consultant unit/Home birth/BBA</li> <li>• Hospital: Borders General Hospital</li> <li>• Time &amp; Date of birth</li> <li>• Sex of baby</li> </ul>	
<b>Consideration for postnatal transfer: discuss with appropriate on call medical staff</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maternal pyrexia</li> <li>• Maternal blood loss over 500mls</li> <li>• Tear requiring further assessment, possible 3<sup>rd</sup> degree tear.</li> <li>• Meconium stained liquor</li> <li>• Weight 2000-25000g</li> <li>• Weight &gt;4500g</li> <li>• Maternal GBS + ve swab result with neonatal concerns on any PN examination.</li> <li>• SRM&gt;24 HRS if signs of infection present in either woman or neonate, if any concerns.</li> <li>• Neonatal temperature below 36.5</li> </ul>	
<b>Postnatal:</b> Postnatal Assessment for Mother and Baby Daily Examination and Feeding Review.	
<b>Record Named and buddy midwife identified for PN period when creating PN care plan.</b>	
<b>Child Protection</b> alert various teams notified and emailed
