- A NAMED LEAD FOR ADULT SUPPORT & PROTECTION (ASP) AND CHILD PROTECTION WHO CAN ORGANISE TRAINING, ADVISE STAFF AND OVERSEE CONCERNS IS AVAILABLE IN YOUR AREA/PRACTICE ☐
- ASP & CHILD PROTECTION POLICIES THAT SET OUT THE COMMITMENT TO PROTECT PATIENTS AT RISK OF HARM ARE VISIBLE TO ALL STAFF MEMBERS ☐
- MANDATORY TRAINING IN ASP & CHILD PROTECTION IS AVAILABLE TO ALL STAFF MEMBERS AND STAFF KNOW WHERE THEY CAN ACCESS THIS ☐
- ALL STAFF ARE AWARE OF THEIR PERSONAL & PROFESSIONAL RESPONSIBILITY TO REPORT CONCERNS AND ARE AWARE OF THE REPORTING PROCESS ☐
- ASP & CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING IS INCLUDED AS PART OF THE STAFF INDUCTION PROCESS ☐
- PROCEDURES FOR INFORMATION SHARING AND WORKING WITH OTHER AGENCIES TO PROTECT ADULT AND CHILDREN AT RISK ARE EASILY ACCESSIBLE FOR ALL STAFF ☐
- SAFE RECRUITMENT PRACTICES FOR RELEVANT ROLES ARE IN PLACE ☐
- ASP AND CHILD PROTECTION IS INCORPORATED INTO TEAM MEETINGS ☐
- ALL STAFF MEMBERS ARE AWARE OF HOW TO CONTACT THE LOCAL PUBLIC PROTECTION HEALTH TEAM ☐
